## **Partnerships and Innovation for SME Finance**

Small and medium enterprises (SMEs) are crucial for job creation and economic growth in both developed and developing countries. Globally, however, approximately half of small businesses are restrained from getting off the ground or growing. Key constraints include limited access to affordable financing, unfavorable regulatory environments, and lack of suitable financial products and services, to name a few.

Financial institutions play an essential role in addressing these challenges, but cannot solve the problems alone. Partnerships are critical. Strategic partnerships allow financial institutions to provide new services to their customers, reach them in new ways, and compete more effectively with the growing number of nontraditional sources of finance.

This inaugural Global SME Finance Forum focuses on partnerships as critical component to accelerating the growth of SMEs, especially in emerging markets.
